

Take Leadership seriously

1 Peter 2

Romans 12:8 (New Living Translation)

If your gift is to encourage others, be encouraging. If it is giving, give generously. If God has given you leadership ability, take the responsibility seriously. And if you have a gift for showing kindness to others, do it gladly.

1. Outcomes / Results

20% of your time actually results in 80% of your outcome

Be involved in the outcomes not the processes of your teams

2. Team Building

Collaboration – consult team members, value their input and allow their suggestions to shape your decision making processes.

3. Recruiting

Speak to 3 people a week about where they would like to serve in ministry and their specific passions.

4. Developing Others

Training others – the best input you can have is when its most relevant. (on the spot teaching moments, suggestions of other options and asking the question of “why can’t it, they or she do, that, it or something completely different”)

Inspect the things you expect – good steward ship requires that you eye ball results.

What can I do through communication to reinforce our vision, values and core beliefs. How can I use email, text and handouts to remind people of things I have already spoken to them about verbally. (face to face and by phone).
